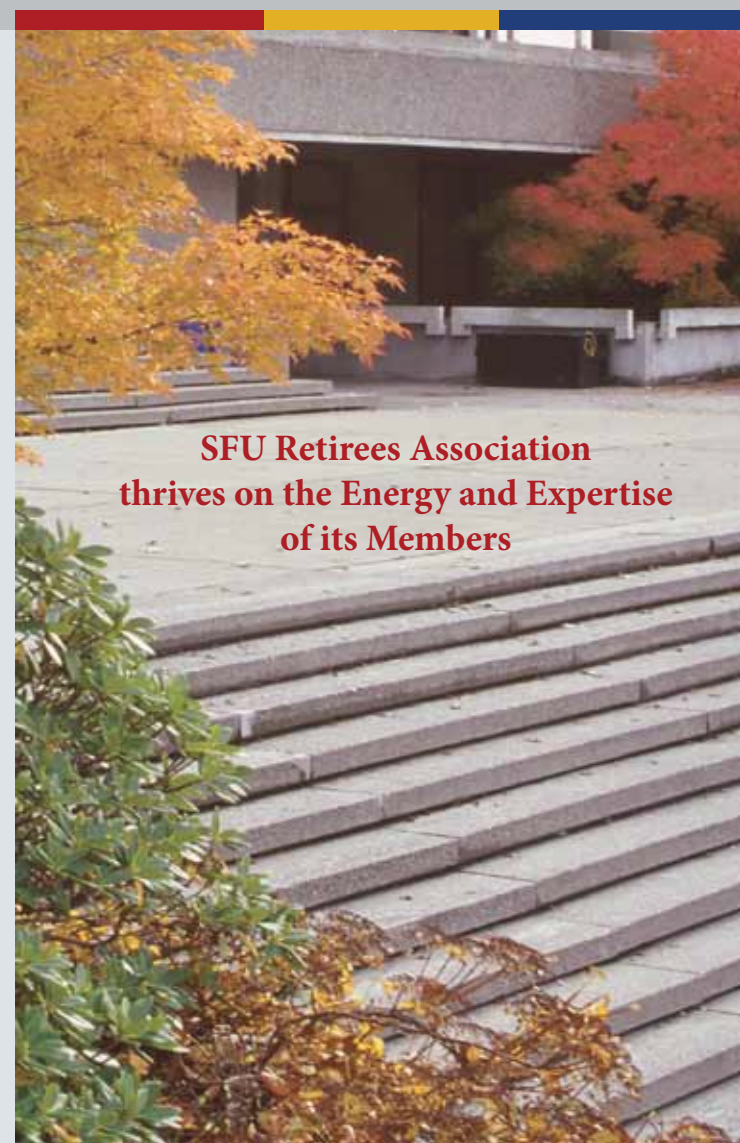
Annual dues: (\$30.00) includes limited parking at SFU Burnaby, Library and Gym privileges, regular newsletters, and notices and discounts for all events.

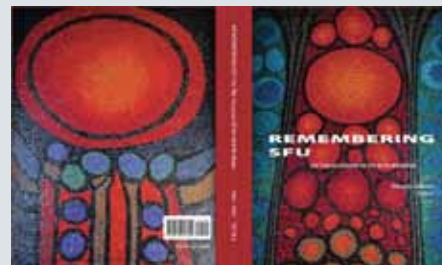
